COUNCIL 4130'S ANNUAL FAMILY PICNIC SUNDAY AUGUST 22

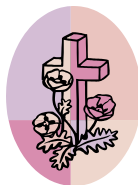

July's Knights of the Month was PGK Kevin Ineman.

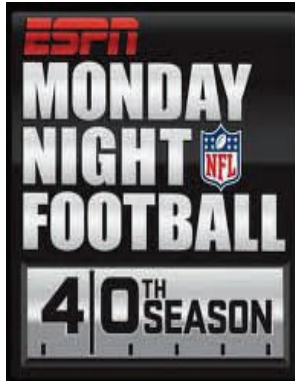
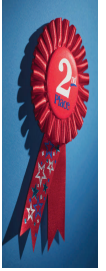


